

5 Step Program for Fescue Lawns

- 1.) **February:** Crabgrass control with fertilizer. Spot treat, or blanket application broadleaf weeds with a liquid or granular weed control. Weed control can be applied every 3 weeks to 30 days. Do not plan to overseed at this time because crabgrass control and broadleaf weed control will inhibit seed germination
- 2.) **April:** Crabgrass control with fertilizer and continue to treat spring weeds every 3 weeks to 30 days.
- 3.) **June-July:** Classic lawn food is a maintenance fertilization to keep the lawn healthy through the summer month. Do not treat at this time.
- 4.) Mid September Mid November: Fall seeding and new lawn starter. Core aeration and lime can also be done at this time. Do not treat broadleaf weeds at this time.
- 5.) **November:** Apply Fertilome winterizer to green up existing turf, and keep new grass healthy though the winter.
